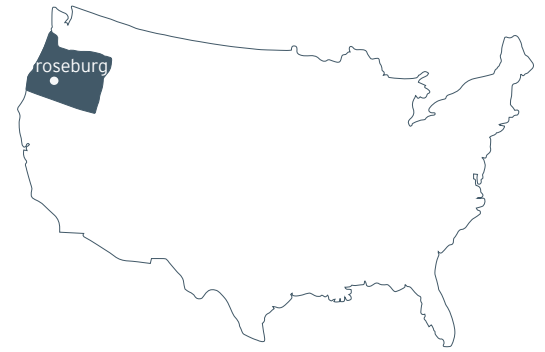




EVERGREEN MEDICAL CLINIC: NEW CLINIC AND RELOCATE CEO SUITE

Existing Space

The Evergreen Family Medical Center needed to reconfigure the facility to accommodate more staff and doctors. To accomplish this, they decided to move the CEO and business offices into an under used corner of the existing building, and remodel the vacated space for a new clinic.

The newly remodeled 2,715 sf clinic areas include a nurse station, waiting room and exam rooms. Custom glass, skylights, colors and textures give this clinical space character and warmth.







CEO Suite

The business office still needed to incorporate a conference room, so we used a floor-to-ceiling glass-enclosed space in the center as an way to assure privacy while still allowing light to pass through the space. Art glass panels were incorporated into transom windows to soften the light.
